Jörg Schroeder, born 1977, has been on the Executive Board of adesso SE since 1 September 2019 and is responsible for the Finance and Controlling, Investor Relations and Mergers & Acquisitions departments. Before Schroeder was appointed to the Executive Board of adesso SE, the qualified business data processing specialist, LL.M. and Executive MBA was responsible for strategic development and implementation at the BITMARCK Group from 2015 onwards as Chief Strategy Officer and member of the management. Most recently, he was in charge of the Finance, Controlling and Purchasing departments of the Group and all subsidiaries as Chief Financial Officer at BITMARCK Holding GmbH.

Schroeder completed his degree as a qualified business data processing specialist at the University of Duisburg-Essen in 2004, before successfully leading the management consultancy success2business GmbH as an entrepreneur, consultant and co-founder. In 2006 he moved to the Bundesverband der Betriebskrankenkassen (German Federal Association of Company Health Insurance Funds) as an advisor in corporate strategy and investment controlling. Here, he handled the merger projects of statutory health insurance companies and an extensive restructuring programme for company health insurance funds in a managerial capacity.

He joined the BITMARCK Group in 2008, where he took on commercial responsibility for different business units and led the business to long-term success. Alongside working at BITMARCK, Schroeder completed a Master’s in Economic Law and Corporate Structuring (LL.M.) at the University of Münster between 2009 and 2011. He then completed an Executive MBA programme at Kellogg School of Management in Chicago and Otto Beisheim School of Management in Vallendar and Düsseldorf between 2011 and 2013.
